Competency Requirements for Licence to Use Explosives Explosives Act 1999

Licence Purpose

A licence to use explosives is issued to cover any specialised or specific stated purpose on the licence for the use of explosives as opposed to the conventional explosives user licences such as shotfirers and fireworks operators. This document identifies the competency requirements or in certain circumstances, the need for a competency assessment to be conducted by an inspector to demonstrate that the person has the skills, knowledge and experience to carry out the explosives activities.

Competencies Available

Currently the national training packages approved by the chief inspector as the necessary qualification for a licence to use explosives is the Resources and Infrastructure Industry Training Package (RII) and the Creative Arts and Culture Training Package (CUA). The attached table contains specific competencies contained in industry training standards as approved by the chief inspector for the licence to use explosives. The SOA based upon the competency units in the RII and CUA packages will be the only statements accepted for licensing purposes.

Please note: Release 5.0 of the Resources and Infrastructure Industry Training Package was released on the 23rd September 2020. To allow for the transition of this release, immediately superseded or equivalent units of competency, applicable to the current units listed on page three and four, will be accepted for licensing purposes until 23rd September 2021.

New Applicants

Where the competencies as detailed in the attached matrix exist, applicants must have, within the 5 year period ending on the day the application is made, been assessed by a registered training organisation. The approved registered training organisations are listed at www.rshq.qld.gov.au.

Renewing Applicants

Licence holders who are renewing their licence to use are advised to clearly define their requirements for their licensing needs to the RTO undertaking the training so the correct competencies can be attained. The statement of attainment must be dated within 5 years on the day the licence is due to expire.

This table is not exhaustive. A licence to use explosives may be issued for an activity not covered below. Please contact your nearest regional office of the explosives inspectorate before applying for a licence of this type.

How to use table/s:

The applicant must obtain each competency indicated by an 'X' in one of the columns relevant to the licence Class applied for.

<u>For example</u>: an applicant who seeks a licence use for Explosives Detection Dogs must have attained the relevant competencies below.

Licence to Use Explosives - Purpose

X = Mandatory

- A. Prerequisites Must hold Fireworks Operator Licence for the fireworks to be tested audit against ISO quality standard or equivalent.
- B. Holders of a Shotfirer licence will already have SOA for RIIBLA205E Store, handle and transport explosives and RIIBLA305E Conduct secondary blasting however a letter of endorsement from their employer who is currently licensed and authorised to use explosives for special effects (film & TV) must be provided.
- C. CUAPYR403 competency is mandatory for fireworks contractors only.
- D. Competencies CUAPYR403 Plan an outdoor fireworks display only apply to Contractors, RIIRIS402E Carry out the risk management processes or equivalent should be conducted as a minimum for operators and a higher level risk management unit is required for contractors and/or special effects supervisors.
- E. Adapted competency package from Fireworks competencies developed by OHS Media specifically for battlefield effects (HD 1.3 and 1.4).
- F. Fireworks operators applying for special effects are restricted to pyrotechnics & propellants only
